You have now completed NGC1 Element One.

Spend some time attempting to answer the following questions. Pay attention to the wording of the questions and the points available to give you an idea of how much information is required. To help you, the action verbs have been highlighted in bold.

Question 1:

- a) **Explain THREE** possible defences to a civil law claim of negligence. **(6 marks)**
- b) **State** the circumstances in which an employer may be held vicariously liable. **(2 marks)**

Question 2:

Giving an example in **EACH** case, explain the differences between:

- a) Health and Safety Regulations. **(4 marks)**
- b) HSE Approved Codes of Practice. **(4 marks)**

Question 3:

An employer has a common law duty of care for the health, safety and welfare of their employees. **Giving** an example in **EACH** case, **identify** what the employer must provide in order to fulfil this common law duty of care. **(8 marks)**

Question 4:

- a) **Outline FOUR** powers available to an inspector when investigating a workplace accident. **(4 marks)**
- b) **Identify** the **TWO** types of enforcement notice that may be served by an inspector, stating the conditions that must be satisfied before **EACH** type of notice is served. **(4 marks)**

Question 5:

- a) **Explain**, giving an example in **EACH** case, the circumstances under which a health and safety inspector may serve:
 - i. An improvement notice. **(3 marks)**
 - ii. A prohibition notice. **(3 marks)**
- b) **State** the effect on **EACH** type of enforcement notice of appealing against it. **(2 marks)**

Question 6:

List **EIGHT** possible costs to an organisation when employees are absent due to work-related ill health. **(8 marks)**

Question 7:

- a) **State FOUR** designer's duties under the Construction Design and Management Regulations 2007. **(4 marks)**
- b) Providing an example in **EACH** case, **outline TWO** ways in which failures on the part of designers to comply with their duties can cause health and safety problems during the *construction phase* of a project. **(4 marks)**

Question 8:

- a) **Identify** the duties of the client for projects that are notifiable under the Construction Design and Management Regulations 2007. **(8 marks)**
